We purchased a laptop computer with the appropriate programs to help our handicap administrator keep us all up-to-date. We will now be able to post year round scores. Although we have some kinks to work out, this new tool will become a great asset to FGA.

We also purchased an e-blast (e-mailing system) to help improve our communications with the

membership. So please make sure to include your e-mail address on your membership application.

The tournament director for Seniors will be Martha Hanlon. Mixed Scotch will be directed by Lana Assyd and Jim Ballam. Lee Williams will be working with Mike Shultz on Fairbanks City Championship. We are very lucky to have such dedicated folks working on our behalf. Please feel free to contact them and volunteer for these FGA sponsored events and any others you can.

It is with a sad heart that I won't be able to commit the time and energy necessary for the Junior Golf program this year. I have started discussions with others on continuing this program, and I am looking for volunteers to help as well. This is such an important part of golf and the community we all need to be there for the kids!!! If we are unable to continue the nine week season there will be other formats we can choose. Don't let junior golf programs expire. They need your help!!

Another suggestion that came to us this past fall/winter is updating our FGA logo. We have decided to put on a contest for a new and improved logo and the winner of that contest will be voted upon and named at the fall meeting. We will accept designs all summer and will close one week before the fall meeting (to be determined).

## Treasurer's Report – from Martha Hanlon

The Profit and Loss statement from March 2009 – March 2010 is attached. Our net income was approximately \$934.00 in the red for the year. This discrepancy represents Junior Golf expenses that exceeded revenues as well as a slight loss on the Senior Tournament. Typically, we try to budget based on anticipated fees/participation and these figures do not always pencil out. In addition, we had some added fees on website management that we had not planned.

During the winter, I put the FGA accounts into QuickBooks. Tracking expenses and creating reports is much simpler; I am still working on how detailed we need to be in expense tracking beyond large categories and this will continue to evolve. I hope I can pass this file onto future treasurers and maintain a good continuity in our accounting in the future.

We have started 2010 with a few new expenses out of the box: we purchased a new FGA laptop and a blast email program, which should enhance our ability to communicate with members.

Our accounts are solid and we have a healthy reserve. As of March 25, 2010, we had \$4,969 in our Checking and \$11,900 in our Savings account.
